#### D. WORKSHOP

The Department discussed the status of the City's Shoreline Master Program (SMP) updates, including the regulatory background of the SMP; the difference between the Comprehensive and Periodic updates; the draft Plan approved via Resolution by City Council in 2016; and the legislative process to open up the Plan to public comment and ultimately adopt any changes.

The Planning Commission requested clarification on which amendments were statutorily required and which changes could be subject to local modification. CDS proposed an additional workshop to present the draft, and hosting an Open House event for the community prior to holding a Public Hearing with the Planning Commission. The Planning Commission requested that CDS prepare a map showing the proposed Critical Areas Buffers within shoreline jurisdiction. The Department agreed to put a link on the Shoreline Master Plan project website to the table of required changes provided by the Department of Ecology.
