Resolution enacted to change the form of government :

Whereas the City of Blaine, State of Washington, is organized under the Council-Manager form of government, and whereas the said City has a population more than 2,000 and not more than 30,000 residents according to the 2000 census;

And whereas it is felt by the Council that it will be for the best interest of the people of the City to have a Mayor-Council form of government;

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLAINE DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS :

Section 1. The City shall adopt the Mayor-Council form of government pursuant to R.C.W. Chapter 35.A13.

Section 2. The Mayor of the City is hereby requested to, within ten (10) days of filing of this resolution with the Clerk, issue a proclamation placing before the electorate at a time specified, the question as to whether the City should adopt the Mayor-Council form of government.
